This grant is subject to the following conditions:

1. Cosecha Communications, LLC is encouraged to take reasonable steps to market the trust station to businesses owned by women and minorities, and is strongly encouraged to file an application for consent to assign the license of the trust station within six months of the date of consummation of the Access.1 transfer of control. To that end, Cosecha is required to take all commercially reasonable efforts to effectuate sale of the trust station.

2. If Cosecha has not submitted a complete assignment of license application for the sale of the trust station within six months of the consummation date, it must provide the Commission with a confidential report that documents its efforts to sell the station, and must provide such a report every six months thereafter until it has submitted a complete assignment of license application for the sale of the trust station. The confidential report shall contain, at a minimum, the following information:

a. The minimum price, if any, set the trust station; by whom that price was set (e.g., Access.1, Cosecha); the basis for the minimum price (e.g., multiple of cash flow, comparable station sales); and, if applicable, the basis for any revisions to minimum prices;

b. A description of all efforts to market the trust station, including all efforts to market the trust station to women and minorities;

c. A list of all offers made for the trust station and the consideration offered for each;

d. For each offer for the trust station, a description of Cosecha's response (e.g., rejection, counter-offer, negotiations still underway).

3. The subject station, KCUL-FM, Marshall, Texas, has a currently pending license renewal application and is being assigned to Cosecha Communications, LLC, as Trustee. In cases involving the assignment, as opposed to transfer, until determination of the future use of the KCUL-FM frequency, all that is assignable is the right to continue operation of those stations pending action upon their license renewal applications. See American Broadcasting Companies, Inc., Memorandum Opinion and Order, 7 FCC 2d 245, 261 (1966), citing Application of Stevens Broadcasting, Inc., and Fred P. D'Angelo, Memorandum Opinion and Order, 3 R.R. 2d 840, 843-844 (1964), aff'd on other grounds sub nom. Parr v. FCC, 344 F.2d 539 (D.C. Cir. 1965). Accordingly, our consent herein granted goes only to the assignment of that station's continuing authorization to operate, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. Section 307(c)(3), during the pendency of its application for license renewal (File No. BRH-20130329ADZ).

Under authority of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, the consent of the Federal Communications Commission is hereby granted to the transaction indicated above.

The Commission's consent to the above is based on the representations made by the applicants that the statements contained in, or made in connection with, the application are true and that the undertakings of the parties upon which this transaction is authorized will be carried out in good faith.

The actual consummation of voluntary transactions shall be completed within 90 days from the date hereof, and notice in letter form thereof shall promptly be furnished to the Commission by the seller or buyer showing the date the acts necessary to effect the transaction were completed. Upon furnishing the Commission with such written notice, this transaction will be considered completed for all purposes related to the above described station(s).

FCC Form 323, Ownership Report, must be filed within 30 days after consummation, by the licensee/permittee or assignee.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ASSIGNMENTS ONLY:

Upon consummation the assignor must deliver the permit/license, including any modifications thereof to the assignee.

It is hereby directed that, upon consummation, a copy of this consent be posted with the station authorization(s) as required by the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

The assignee is not authorized to construct nor operate said station(s) unless and until notification of consummation in letter form has been forwarded to the Commission.
