Special operating conditions or restrictions:

The relative field strength of neither the measured horizontally nor vertically polarized radiation component shall exceed at any azimuth the value indicated on the composite radiation pattern authorized by this construction permit.

A relative field strength of 1.0 on the composite radiation pattern herein authorized corresponds to the following effective radiated power:

0.001(H) & 0.75(V) kilowatt.

Principal minima and their associated field strength limits:

170 degrees True: 0.04 kilowatt

Pursuant to 47 CFR Sections 73.7002(c) and 73.7005(b) the permittee/licensee is required to construct and operate for a period of four (4) years of on-air operations technical facilities substantially as proposed and shall not downgrade service to the area on which the preference was based.
