- 3 FAA INTERFERENCE CONDITION: Upon receipt of notification from the Commission that harmful interference is being caused by the operation of the permittee's/licensee's transmitter, the permittee's/licensee's shall either immediately reduce the power to the point of no interference, cease operation, or take such immediate corrective action as is necessary to eliminate the harmful interference. This condition expires after one year of interference-free operation.
