Pursuant to the grant of this construction permit and the authority found in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303 and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b), 0.283, 1.420, 73.203(b), and 73.3573 of the Commission's Rules, the FM assignment IS MODIFIED as follows:

Community Channel No. Hazen, NV Add 297C Fernley, NV Delete 297C

Pursuant to Section 316(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, license BLH-20120831AAL IS MODIFIED to specify operation on Channel 297C at Hazen, Nevada, in lieu of Channel 297C at Fernley, Nevada.

BEFORE PROGRAM TESTS COMMENCE, sufficient measurements shall be made to establish that the operation authorized in this construction permit is in compliance with the spurious emissions requirements of 47 CFR Sections 73.317(b) through 73.317(d). All measurements must be made with all stations simultaneously utilizing the shared antenna. These measurements shall be submitted to the Commission along with the FCC 302-FM, Application For FM Brodcast Station License.

Permittee has specified use of a 14 bay, EPA type 4, horizontally polarized, nondirectional FM transmitting antenna with 1.0-wavelength bay spacing, to demonstrate compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure quidelines. If any other type or size of antenna is used with the facilities authorized herein, THE AUTOMATIC PROGRAM TEST PROVISIONS OF 47 CFR SECTION 73.1620 WILL NOT APPLY. In this case, a FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROGRAM TEST AUTHORITY must be filed in conjunction with FCC 302-FM, Application For FM Broadcast Station License, BEFORE program tests will be authorized. The request must include a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the FCC guidelines.

The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
