Dear Licensee:

This refers to your attorney's letter dated May 18, 2015 requesting special temporary authority to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate that on or about April 12, 2015, KLCW-TV experienced a serious unexplained problems that caused the destruction of a large number of transistors in the final amplifier of the transmitter. The transmitter is now capable of producing approximately 500 Watts, or 10% of the licensed power. You state that reduced power operations will continue to be necessary while the applicant is trying to repair the equipment and restore full power operation.

In light of the above, special temporary authority pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules until December 18, 2015 IS GRANTED.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
