Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, subsequent acts and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions set forth in this permit, the permittee is hereby authorized to construct the radio transmitting apparatus herein described. Installation and adjustment of equipment not specifically set forth herein shall be in accordance with representations contained in the permittee's application for construction permit except for such modifications as are presently permitted, without application, by the Commission's Rules.

Commission rules which became effective on February 16, 1999, have a bearing on this construction permit. See Report & Order, Streamlining of Mass Media Applications, MM Docket No. 98-43, 13 FCC RCD 23056, Para. 77-90 (November 25, 1998); 63 Fed. Reg. 70039 (December 18, 1998). Pursuant to these rules, this construction permit will be subject to automatic forfeiture unless construction is complete and an application for license to cover is filed prior to expiration. See Section 73.3598.

- 1 PROGRAM TESTS FOR WKZQ-FM (FACILITY ID# 24776) WILL NOT COMMENCE ON CHANNEL 269C1 UNTIL PROGRAM TESTS FOR WMGL (FACILITY ID# 61592) COMMENCE ON CHANNEL 297C3 AND A LICENSE WILL NOT BE GRANTED FOR WKZQ ON CHANNEL 269C1 UNTIL A LICENSE IS GRANTED FOR WMGL ON CHANNEL 297C3.
- 2 The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

Special operating conditions or restrictions:

- 3 Pursuant to the grant of this construction permit and the authority found in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303 and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b), 0.283, 1.420, 73.203(b), and 73.3573 of the Commission's Rules, the assignment for WKZQ-FM IS AMENDED as follows:

Hanahan, SC	Add 269C1, Delete 269C

Pursuant to Section 316(a) of the Communication Act of 1934, as amended, the license for WKZQ-FM, Hanahan, SC IS MODIFIED to specify operation on Channel 269C1 in lieu of Channel 269C.

- 4 Upon commencement of program tests in accordance with Section 73.1620, the licensee must cease use of the auxiliary facility authorized by BMLH-19900404KA due to a violation of Section 73.1675(a)(1). The licensee must surrender the this auxiliary license for cancellation at that time.

- 5 BEFORE PROGRAM TESTS COMMENCE, sufficient measurements shall be made to establish that the operation authorized in this construction permit is in compliance with the spurious emissions requirements of 47 C.F.R. Sections 73.317(b) through 73.317(d). All measurements must be made with all stations simultaneously utilizing the shared antenna. These measurements shall be submitted to the Commission along with the FCC Form 302-FM application for license.
