Special operating conditions or restrictions:

- The permittee/licensee must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC quidelines.
- The permittee has certified compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure guidelines based on the use of a Collins 37-CP6, 6 section antenna and the facilities authorized herein. If the permittee makes any changes in the facilities, including changes in the type or size of antenna to be used, THE AUTOMATIC PROGRAM TEST PROVISIONS OF 47 C.F.R. SECTION 73.1620 WILL NOT APPLY. In this case, a FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROGRAM TEST AUTHORITY must be filed in conjunction with the FCC Form 302-FM, Application for License, BEFORE program tests will be authorized. This request should be made at least 10 days prior to the date on which program tests are desired to commence. The request must include a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the FCC guidelines.

Documentation demonstrating compliance with the FCC radiofrequency field exposure guidelines may be submitted in advance of the filing of the FCC Form 302-FM. The Commission's staff will review it for compliance and respond by letter stating whether automatic PTA has been reinstated.
