Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, subsequent acts and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions set forth in this permit, the permittee is hereby authorized to construct the radio transmitting apparatus herein described. Installation and adjustment of equipment not specifically set forth herein shall be in accordance with representations contained in the permittee's application for construction permit except for such modifications as are presently permitted, without application, by the Commission's Rules.

This authorization is for a share time operation with WGXM(FM), Dayton, OH, which is licensed to the Northridge Local Board of Education.

The University of Dayton is authorized to operate with the facilities authorized herein as follows:

From August 25th through May 31st,

- (1) Monday through Friday: 12PM to 7AM;
- (2) Saturday and Sunday: 24 hours.

From June 1st through August 24th, 24 hours daily.

- 2 The permittee/licensee must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
- 3 This construction permit is for a Class D secondary station.
