**REPLY TO
OPPOSITION TO PETITION TO DENY**

Lake Powell Communications, Inc. ("Lake Powell"), by counsel, hereby submits this Reply to the "Opposition to Petition to Deny" filed October 29, 2018 by Redrock Radio Group LLC ("Redrock"). In support hereof, Lake Powell submits the following:

1. Red Rock argues that the service area of its proposed facility will include a substantial amount of "white area" thereby warranting a waiver of Section 74.1232(d) of the Commission's Rules. Red Rock claims that the white area includes the tribal villages of the Navajo Mountain Chapter in Tonalea, Utah and the Navajo Mountain Chapter. Red Rock supports its argument with an engineering statement prepared by Roy P. Stype, III.

2. Attached hereto as Exhibit No. 1 is the sworn statement of Janet Brown, President of Lake Powell, dated November 6, 2018. In response to Red Rock's opposition pleading, Ms. Brown drove the exact areas identified by Red Rock as "white area" and she could clearly pick up eight (8) radio signals. As Ms. Brown's statement further indicates, residents of that area told her that they also listen to two additional radio signals.

Therefore, irrespective of the theoretical technical studies, in reality the area is well served by radio stations.

3. Ms. Brown's statement also confirms a September 29, 2018 telephone conversation she had with Red Rock's president wherein he talked about moving his radio signal into Page. Ms. Brown further states that the community of Page is the only place in that area that has potential radio revenue. As such, the FCC needs to recognize that Red Rock's supposed desire to serve white areas is merely a sham.

4. As a gesture of good faith, Lake Powell is willing to work with Red Rock to retain an independent, third party to drive the areas identified by Red Rock in order to confirm Ms. Brown's findings. We respectfully submit that, before the Commission considers Red Rock's waiver request it should accept the findings of a third party technical observer.

In light of the foregoing, Lake Powell continues to submit that pending application BPFT-20180927ABP must be DENIED.

My name is Janet Brown, President and owner of Lake Powell Communications in Page Arizona. I offer this statement in response to Petition for Opposition to Deny filed by Red Rock Radio Group.

I drove to the area of Navajo Mountain Chapter in Tonalea, Utah, the Navajo Mountain Chapter House to verify or not if this is a "white area" with no broadcast signals. Upon arriving at the Chapter House, I was able in my car radio (a Toyota Highlander 2012) to receive these radio signals loud and clear:

Navajo Mountain Chapter is one of the eighteen Chapters which make up the Western Agency, one of five agencies which make up the Navajo Nation. As of the 2010 census, the Chapter had a total population of 542, of which 501 were Navajo. It has an estimated elevation of 5,886 feet (1,794 m) above sea level.

Page, Arizona is the only location for potential radio revenue business in the entire coverage area.
