**REPLY TO OPPOSITION AND SECOND SUPPLEMENT**  
**TO INFORMAL OBJECTION**

Media-Com, Inc. ("Media-Com"), by its attorneys and acting pursuant to Sections 1.45, AND 73.3587 of the Commission Rules hereby submits to the Media Bureau ("Bureau") this Reply to Opposition and Second Supplement to its Informal Objection (this "Objection") to the above-captioned application (the "Application").

On May 6, 2020, Media-Com submitted an Informal Objection to the referenced application, advising the Commission staff that, as proposed, the modified W229CG facility would result in substantial interference to regular listeners of WNIR(FM) at locations within WNIR's 45 dBu contour. Media-Com notified the Commission that it was undertaking commercially reasonable efforts to arrive at a private resolution of the issues presented by the W229CG application as required by the recently released Report & Order in FCC Docket 19-40<sup>1</sup> Unfortunately, those efforts have been unsuccessful. On May 6, 2020, Media-Com filed a Supplement by which it perfected its Informal Objection with all of the requirements specified in

the Report and Order and revised Section 74.1204(f) of the Commission's Rules<sup>2</sup>. In each of its pleadings, Media-Com carefully complied with all requirements of the FCC substantive and procedural rules. Each pleading contained a certificate of service demonstrating service that a copy was delivered to the applicant both by US first-class mail and PDF email attachment and Commission staff via PDF email attachment.

Unfortunately, Media-Com was unaware that Radio.com had filed an opposition to Media-Com's original Informal Objection on April 30, 2020. Without knowledge of this filing, Media-Com was unable to respond to it. Serendipitously, Media-Com first learned of the Radio.com Opposition on May 12, while checking the docket in LMS to be sure that its Supplement had been properly filed. Had Media-Com known of Radio.com's Opposition, it would have responded to it at that time, as permitted by FCC rules. However, as evidenced by the lack of a certificate of service, Radio.com never served its Opposition on Media-Com, its counsel, or for that matter, possibly not on Commission staff. Accordingly, Media-Com requests that this Reply to Opposition be accepted for filing in combination with its Second Supplement to Informal Objection.

### **Second Supplement to Informal Objection**

In its first Supplement to Informal Objection, Media-Com submitted twenty-three regular listeners, well more than the required number, within the area of predicted interference together with their listener surveys and an Engineering Study showing their listening location within the WNIR 45 dBu contour and showing that the undesired to desired signal ratio at each location exceeds -6 dB, meeting the required standard at subsection (f)(5), and confirming that interference is predicted to WNIR at each of these locations.<sup>3</sup> With this Second Supplement,

Media-Com submits documentation regarding twenty additional regular listeners, with all the required showings of location and undesired to desired signal ratio at the listening location. When combined with the loss of several previously claimed listeners resulting from the reduction of the proposed translator power from 99 watts to 25 watts, this brings the number of WNIR's regular listeners predicted to receive interference within its 45 dBu contour to thirty-five; more than three times the number required by the rule. See Attachment "1".

### **Radio.com's Failure to Comply with Commission Pleading Rules**

#### **Verification**

Radio.com's Opposition failed to comply with a number of substantive and procedural Commission Rules. Radio.com submitted its Opposition *pro se*. It makes material representations of fact regarding its alleged drive by listening test, the state of "modern radio equipment" and the state of and condition of its own equipment. However, it does not include a sworn declaration under penalty of perjury or any other verification of the document required of a party not represented by an attorney and it bears no address as required by Commission rule<sup>4</sup> to support them.<sup>5</sup> As a matter of fact, as demonstrated in the attached Engineering Statement of Roy Stype, III of Carl E. Smith Consulting Engineers (the "Engineering Statement"), many of Radio.com's assertions are not only contrary to fact, but demonstrate a total lack of understanding of FM signals, FM radio interference, and FM receiver characteristics. The testing proposed by Radio.com would be a fruitless waste of time. Moreover, the interference area that would be created by the W229CG proposal is so riddled with WNIR regular listeners, a random drive through the area would be of little value. The Engineering Statement has now verified 35

regular WNIR listeners who are predicted to receive interference from the proposed translator facilities at locations within WNIR's predicted 45 dBu contour.

### **Service on Parties and Commission Staff**

This instant Application is for an authority under Title III of the Communications Act, and is, therefore, a restricted proceeding.<sup>6</sup> Radio.com did not attach a certificate of service and, in fact, it did not serve Media-Com or its counsel with a copy of its Opposition as required by Sections 1.521 and 1.47 of the Commission's rules.<sup>7</sup> Indeed, without such service, the Opposition constitutes an impermissible, unlawful, *ex parte* presentation and should be stricken from the record as its Application is not an exempt matter<sup>8</sup> which would warrant a referral to the Office of General Counsel pursuant to Section 1.1214 of the Commission's rules.<sup>9</sup>

### **Disregard for Commission Rules and Rulemaking Process**

Radio.com proposes a novel testing process to demonstrate that first adjacent channel interference will not occur under its proposal. In its effort to arrive at a commercially reasonable private resolution, Media-com considered the proposal but rejected it as not feasible nor useful as the basis for a commercially reasonable private resolution. Therefore, Radio.com appears to have turned to the FCC in its Opposition, implying that the Commission should require the testing it proposes. In that posture, Radio.com's pleading is tantamount to seeking rule type enforcement.

As acknowledged in the Opposition, the FCC has only recently completed an extensive notice and comment rulemaking process that established a new interference standard to govern FM translator requests for facilities modification that can be demonstrated to create, or as built

are creating interference to regular listeners of full-power, primary service licensed FM radio stations. Making no request for a waiver of the FCC rules, and based on the applicant's unverified personal observation of the operation of W262DM, Elyria, Ohio, the Opposition seeks an experiment to conclusively demonstrate that first adjacent channel interference will not be result from its proposed operation. As explained more fully in the Engineering Statement, Radio.com's argument displays a total lack of understanding of FM signals and interference, as well as FM receiver characteristics.<sup>10</sup> The Report and Order does not contemplate the process suggested by Radio.com. Rather, attempting to obtain FCC enforcement of an *ad hoc* testing process not contemplated or provided for in the FCC rules by a pleading in a restricted proceeding demonstrates a disregard for the notice and comment process that led to the Report and Order and, at best, lack of knowledge, or at worst, a disregard for the proper rulemaking process required under the Administrative Procedures Act.<sup>11</sup> Seeking to have the FCC approve or enforce the type of testing suggested by Radio.com would require the FCC to provide the public with adequate notice of a proposed rule followed by a meaningful opportunity to comment.<sup>12</sup> Therefore, this argument is inappropriate for Commission consideration in a restricted application proceeding designed to apply existing FCC rules and should be stricken from the Opposition.

### **Section 74.1203 Interference**

With this Reply, Media-Com has now submitted 35 regular WNIR listeners who would be predicted to receive interference from the proposed W229CG facilities at locations within WNIR's relevant predicted contour and based on the growing frequency of listener response, media-Com is confident that many more are on the way. Figure 2.1 demonstrates also,

that these listeners are not clustered in one area, but are scattered throughout the contour, so directionalization, even were it feasible, would offer no solution. Were the Application to be granted and Radio.com to begin operation, Media-Com is confident that it would need to seek immediate and emergency relief under §74.1203 to eliminate actual interference caused to these thirty-five regular WNIR listeners and many more.


Upon analysis, the striking thing about the Application, is that it seeks an unjustified and dangerous solution to its problem, while ignoring a likely far better solution. Presently limited in power on Channel 229 due to its status as an other area translator, it has proposed 99 watts on channel 260 as a fill-in translator for WKDD. A preliminary analysis show that it should be possible to propose operation on Channel 229 with up to about 30 watts as a fill in translator, and possibly up to about 50 watts were it to employ an antenna with increased downward suppression.

### **Summary**

The basic facts regarding the subject application were set forth in the Informal Objection. As stated therein, all the condition precedent requirements of Section 74.1204(f) have been met and Media-Com has engaged in a meaningful, but unsuccessful effort at a private resolution. Moreover, through its pleading practice, Radio.com has demonstrated not only a lack of knowledge of established principles of sound engineering practice, but either a complete disregard, or at best, a similar lack of knowledge of FCC rules of practice and procedure. The only possible conclusion in this matter is that Radio-com seeks a first adjacent channel to WNIR which would result in substantial interference to more than a sufficient number of WNIR's regular listeners at locations within WNIR's 45 dBu contour and must be denied.

WHEREFORE, having met all the requirements of §74.1204(f) of the Commission's rules as required to protect its station WNIR from predicted adjacent channel interference, Media-Com respectfully requests that the Bureau deny the above captioned application of Radio-Com for a change of channel for FM translator W260DU.



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Fig. 2.1 - WNIR Listener Locations (25 Watt Amendment)





## ENGINEERING STATEMENT

This engineering statement is prepared on behalf of Media-Com, Inc., licensee of Radio Station WNIR(FM) - Kent, Ohio. WNIR operates on Channel 261A with an effective radiated power of 4.2 kilowatts at 120 meters above average terrain. On April 9, 2020, the licensee of FM translator W229CG - Cleveland, Ohio, which presently operates on Channel 229 and is authorized to rebroadcast KHRI(FM) - Hollister, California as relayed by W215BS - Hinckley, Ohio,<sup>1</sup> filed an application (0000111980) for a construction permit to modify the W229CG operating facilities. This application proposed to move W229CG to Channel 260 (99.9 MHz), purportedly to overcome interference presently being received on Channel 229 from cochannel stations WQGR(FM) - North Madison, Ohio and WQIO(FM) - Mount Vernon, Ohio. It also proposed to increase the translator's effective radiated power from 19 watts to 99 watts and change its primary station to a digital subchannel of WKDD(FM) - Munroe Falls, Ohio, as relayed by W224CD - Parma, Ohio. Although it appears to propose no change in the presently licensed W229CG antenna, it does specify a one meter reduction in antenna height and recharacterizes this existing antenna from nondirectional to directional.

On April 29, 2020, the licensee of WNIR filed an informal objection against the W229CG application to request that its processing be deferred while it undertook discussions with the licensee of W229CG regarding predicted interference to regular listeners of WNIR from the proposed W229CG facilities. After these discussions failed to

reach a suitable resolution, this informal objection was supplemented on May 6, 2020 to provide the names and addresses of 23 regular WNIR listeners who would be predicted to receive interference from the proposed W229CG facilities at locations within WNIR's predicted 45 dBu contour.

On April 30, 2020, the licensee of W229CG filed an opposition to the original WNIR objection.<sup>2</sup> The main purpose of this opposition appears to be to attack the FCC's FM interference standards and claim that none of the interference predicted using the criteria outlined in Section 74.1205(f)(5) of the FCC is likely to actually occur.<sup>3</sup> This claim shows a total lack of understanding of FM signals and interference, as well as FM receiver characteristics. This is also not an appropriate forum to make such an argument since a change in interference standards would have to be made in a notice and comment rulemaking proceeding, not in the context of processing an individual application.<sup>4</sup>

The occupied bandwidth of an FM signal is 240 kHz, which alone will occupy the spectrum up to 120 kHz either side of the carrier frequency and overlap 40 kHz into the spectrum occupied by an adjacent channel station. Furthermore, because of inherent nonlinearities in FM transmitters, there will be higher order sideband and inter-modulation products which extend a greater distance from the carrier frequency. As a

result, Section 73.317(b) of the FCC Rules only requires that emissions removed from the carrier frequency by between 120 kHz and 240 kHz be suppressed 25 dB below the carrier, which will result in substantial energy being radiated over most of the remainder of a first adjacent channel, including the carrier frequency, making it virtually impossible for two stations operating on first adjacent channels to provide usable interference free service to the same geographic area since their signals occupy overlapping spectrum. This is aggravated by the fact that the front ends of FM receivers don't have "brick wall" filters that will totally eliminate all signals outside the passband of the desired channel.

The W229CG opposition attempts to discount this by claiming that such interference can be eliminated by installing additional sophisticated filtering on the W229CG transmitter and on all of the receivers expected to receive interference to the reception of WNIR as a result of the operation of W229CG on Channel 260. This totally ignores the spectral information outlined above and would also be impractical since it wouldn't permit these receivers to be tuned to other frequencies without also retuning the external filter and could require the installation of such filters in dozens (or hundreds) of receivers.<sup>5</sup> It also attempts to claim without submitting any valid engineering documentation that the operation of W262DM - Elyria, Ohio with an ERP of 25 watts on WNIR's other first adjacent channel proves their claim that the first adjacent channel interference claimed by WNIR can't possibly occur. This claim is totally immaterial since

W262DM operates in a rural area where WNIR has few if any listeners and is much less densely populated than the area around the W229CG transmitter site.<sup>6</sup>

On May 13, 2020 the W229CG application was amended to reduce the proposed effective radiated power from 99 watts to 25 watts without making any other changes in the proposed facilities.<sup>7</sup> This engineering statement also supports a further supplement to the WNIR informal objection to document that, even at this reduced power, the proposed W229CG facilities will be predicted to cause interference to 35 regular WNIR listeners at locations within WNIR's predicted 45 dBu contour.<sup>8</sup>

Section 74.1204(f)(5) of the FCC Rules defines the signal ratios for determining the presence of interference in the FM translator service. In this particular case, interference will be predicted to WNIR in any area where the predicted WNIR F(50,50) signal does not exceed the predicted F(50,10) signal for the proposed W229CG facilities by at least 6 dB (a U/D ratio exceeding -6 dB). Studies were conducted to evaluate the area in which interference would be predicted to WNIR from the amended proposed translator facilities. The signal calculations in these studies for WNIR utilized terrain data extracted from the NGDC 30 second terrain database and the F(50,50) curves. Those for the proposed translator facilities utilized terrain data extracted from the NGDC 30 second terrain database and the F(50,10) curves. The results of these studies, along with the predicted 60 dBu contour for these proposed translator facilities and

the predicted 45 dBu contour for WNIR's presently licensed facilities, are shown in Figure 2.0. As can be seen from an examination of this figure, these amended proposed translator facilities are still predicted to cause interference to WNIR over an extensive area.

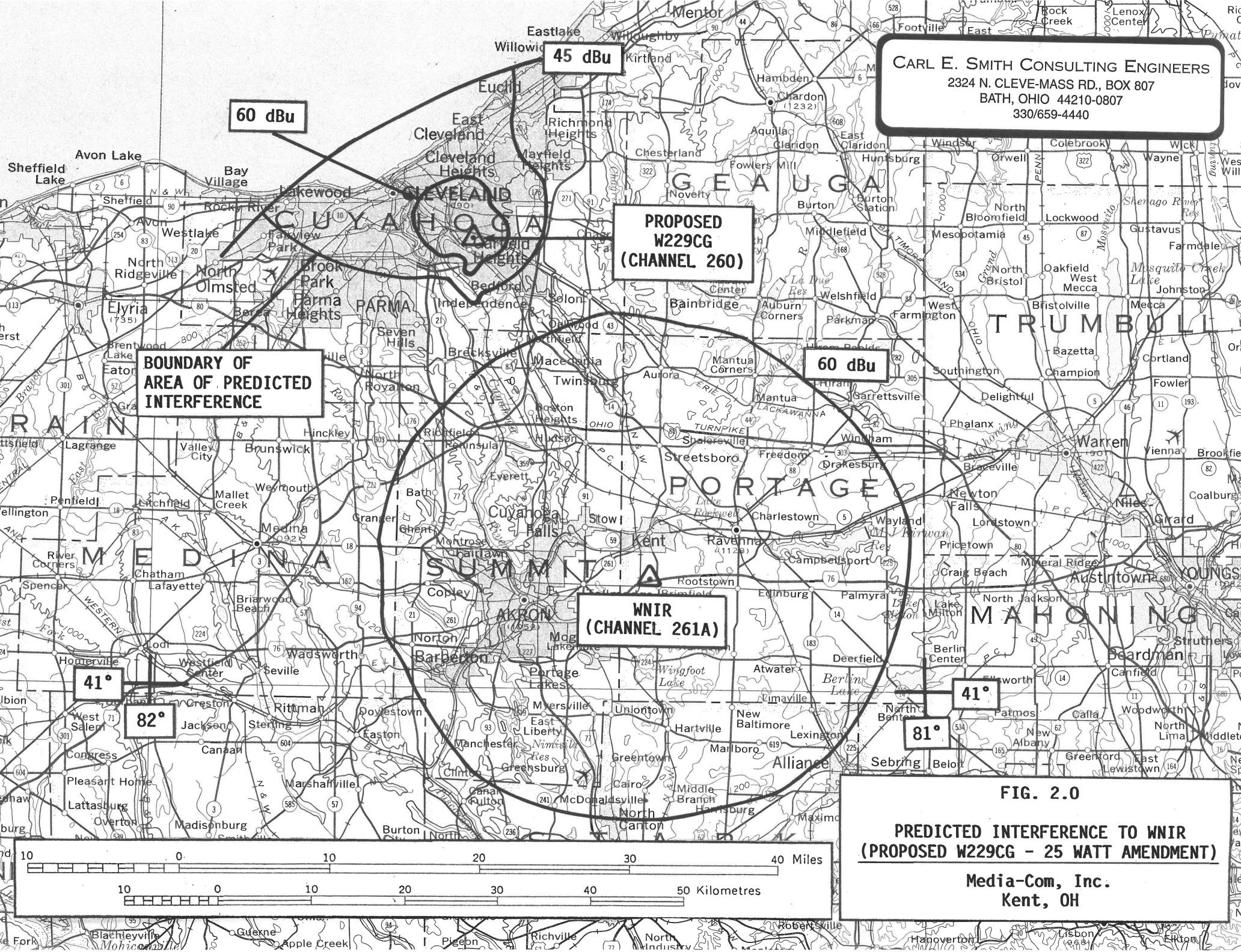
It is recognized that this predicted interference lies entirely outside the predicted WNIR 60 dBu contour, the contour at which WNIR would normally be entitled to protection from other FM broadcast stations. Pursuant to Section 74.1204(f) of the FCC Rules, however, since the proposed facility is a translator, the location of this interference relative to the WNIR 60 dBu contour is immaterial, so long as it is located within WNIR's 45 dBu contour and WNIR can document that it has at least ten regular listeners within this area of predicted interference.<sup>9</sup>

The licensee of WNIR has been able to specifically identify at least 35 regular listeners to WNIR within this area of predicted interference. Figure 2.1 is a detailed map exhibit depicting the locations of these regular listeners in relation to this area of predicted interference. Table 2.1 is a tabulation of the names and addresses of these 35 regular listeners, as well as a summary of the desired (WNIR) and undesired (W229CG) signals at each location and the resulting undesired to desired ("U/D") signal ratio at each location. As shown by this data, the predicted WNIR signal strength at each of these locations exceeds 45 dBu and the undesired to desired signal ratio at each location exceeds -6 dB, which confirms that interference is predicted to WNIR at each of these locations. Thus, pursuant to Section 74.1204(f) of the FCC Rules, even

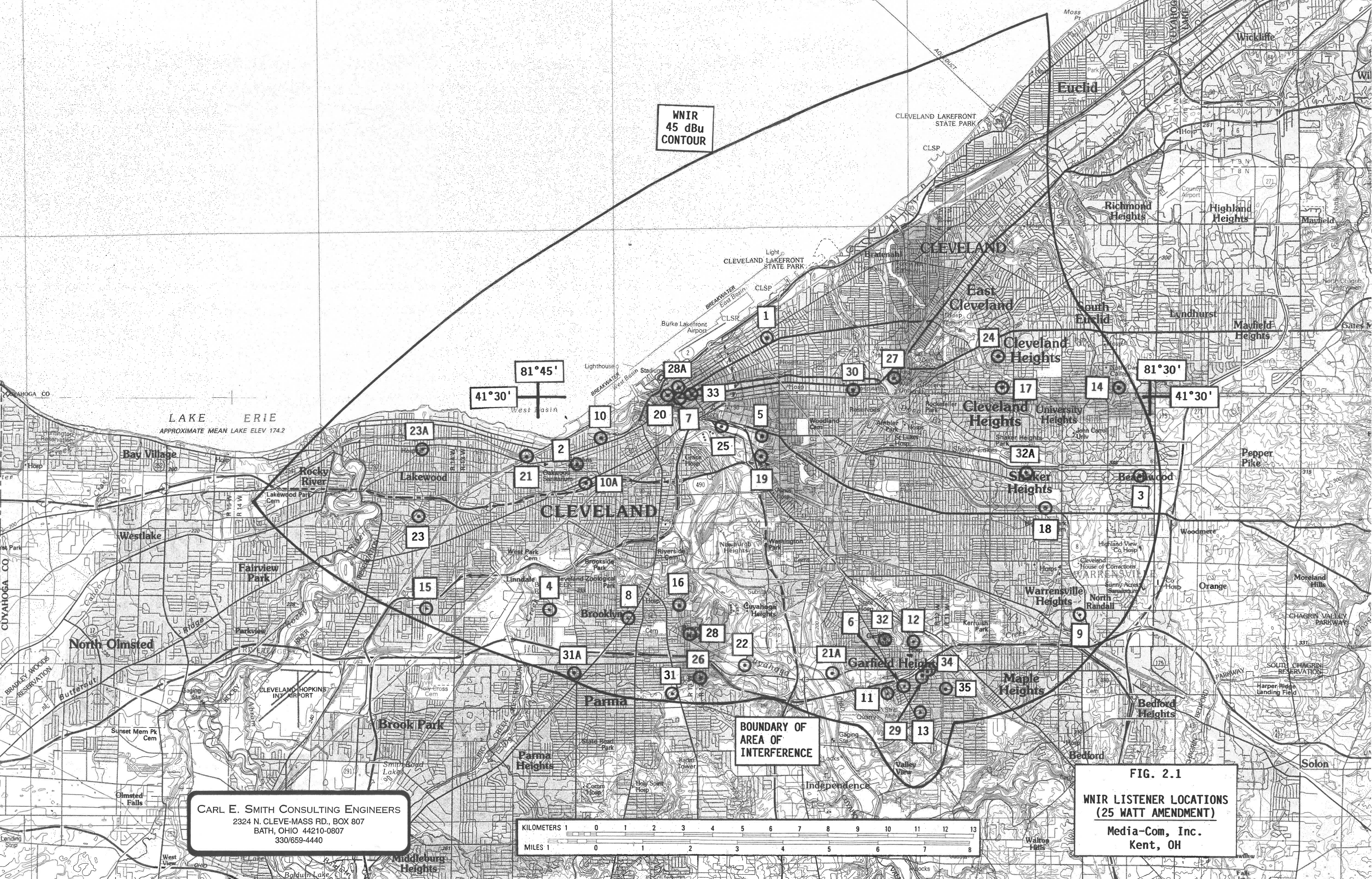

at this reduced power level, the W229CG application must be denied since it is obvious that the proposed translator facilities will result in interference to at least 35 regular listeners of WNIR at locations within the predicted WNIR 45 dBu contour.

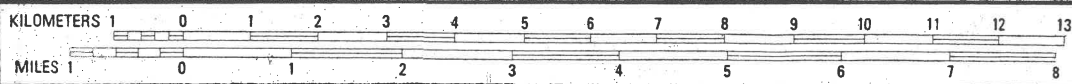
