Re: Informal Objection

The purpose of this objection is to ask for the denial of renewal license for the following station and translators: **KMTL-AM, K249FE, K260DT**

I was informed at the beginning of this year, that there was a new FM station in town, and had a very good coverage in the city of Little Rock and surrounding areas, upon investigating I found out that the station people was referring to, was translator **K260DT (97.7 FM)** assigned to station **KMTL-AM (760AM)** licensed to Sherwood Arkansas. I drove as far as Plumerville AR (45 Miles away from their Translator antenna, and could still hear them. I sent an anonymous complaint using FCC website <https://consumercomplaints.fcc.gov/hc/en-us> hoping someone FCC would notify the licensee and have them turn the power down.

I am not sure if they were notified or not, but several weeks later we received an email notifying us about the station again (We assume this person reached out to us because this station was competing on the same format as our full size FM station) so, I decided to checked again, they were still coming in very strong as if they were a full size FM station as ours. This station is been leased by a radio group along with other signal in the Little Rock Area: **KMTL-AM with 250 watts translator K249FE (97.7 FM)** and **KTUV-AM with 99 watt translator K260DT (99.9 FM)**

I started monitoring both stations and translators, **K260DT** was normal but **K249FE** was always over power, not long after I started monitoring the stations, **KMTL-AM (760AM)** went off the air, for a few days they were airing **KTUV-AM** on both translators while **KMTL-AM (760AM)** was off the air (It's been silent since the end of February till this date) about a week later translator **K260DT** went off the air as well (It has also been off the air up to this date) but translator **K249FE** assigned to station **KMTL-AM (760AM)** has, up to this date simultaneously been broadcasting **KTUV-AM**

Not only translator **K249FE** has been broadcasting the signal of the wrong primary station **KTUV-AM** for almost 3 months but it has also since yesterday been broadcasting as a stand alone station for the past couple of days because now **KTUV-AM** is also off the air.

In conclusion: **K260DT (99.9 FM)** After been operating with unauthorized power has been silent with no STA for over 2 months, **K249FE** has been simultaneously broadcasting the signal of a station other than the primary station, while the primary station has been silent, it has also being broadcasting as a stand alone station as well for the past couple of days, and **KMTL-AM** has allowed **K249FE (97.7 FM)** to broadcast other station's signal while being silent (Their STA would expire this week as well)
