MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Park Public Radio (PPR), licensee of KPPS-LP, files this motion of extension of time until Monday, May 3, 2021 to respond to the Petition to Deny filed by Central Baptist Theological Seminary of Minneapolis (CTS) against the application for minor change to licensed facility of Low Power FM Station KPPS-LP.

Park Public Radio has obtained the email consent of Gregg Skall, attorney for CTS, for a ten day extension of time for PPR to file its Opposition. On April 20, CTS sent PPR a proposal and a request to discuss a possible engineering resolution to this matter. PPR has agreed to meet with CTS representatives to discuss possible resolutions. Additional time is needed to review the CTS proposal, discuss the proposal with CTS representatives, and draft an Opposition based on the latest information.

As both parties are working together to alleviate the concerns raised in the CTS petition, granting this extension will serve the public interest.
