**INTERFERENCE COMPLAINT AND INFORMAL OBJECTION**

LKCM Radio Licenses, L.P, licensee of Station KTFW-FM (Facility ID No. 65314), Glen Rose, TX ("LKCM"), by its counsel, hereby respectfully submits this "Interference Complaint and Informal Objection" to the above referenced application filed by Centro Cristiano De Vida Eterna ("CCDVE") to change channels for Station K229DR to Ch. 221 at Cedar Hill, TX. As demonstrated by the 11 listener complaints and accompanying exhibits which comply with Section 74.1204(f) of the Commission's Rules, the proposed K229DR translator will cause prohibitive interference within Station KTFW-FM's protected contour.

Section 74.1204(f) states:

"An application for an FM translator station will not be accepted for filing even though the proposed operation would not involve overlap of field strength contours with any other station, as set forth in paragraph (a) of this section, if the predicted 1 mV/m field strength contour of the FM translator station will overlap a populated area already receiving a regularly used, off-the-air signal of any authorized co-channel, first, second or third adjacent channel broadcast station, including Class D (secondary) noncommercial educational FM stations and grant of the authorization will result in interference to the reception of such signal."

### Listener Complaint Statements

LKCM has operated Station KTFW-FM from its current site since 2006 when it acquired the station. The station has served a significantly large and loyal audience in the eastern portion of its contour and is requesting the Commission to protect this service from interference that is predicted to occur within the area indicated by Figure 1 of the Engineering Statement provided by Cavell Mertz & Associates Inc. See Attachment A. It should be noted that the proposed K229DR transmitter site is located within Station KTFW-FM's 45 dBu contour. Although LKCM cannot identify all of its listeners that would be impacted in advance of Station K229DR operating as proposed on Ch. 221, LKCM has provided more than the requisite number of statements from current listeners with contact information.<sup>1</sup> See Exhibit 1. As indicated in the Engineering Statement, the 2019 U. S. Census estimated population within Station KTFW-FM's 60 dBu contour is 340, 274 which requires at least 8 listener complaints.

### Location of Complainants

As mentioned, the Declarations from 11 listeners provide their home or driving locations where they listen to Station KTFW-FM. In Figure 1 to the Engineering Statement, the home addresses are plotted on a map where the proposed translator's 60 dBu contour overlaps Station KTFW-FM's 45 dBu contour. If the translator were to be allowed to change channels to Ch. 221 and commence operations, it is clear that these listeners to Station KTFW-FM will receive destructive interference from proposed translator Station K229DR.

### Efforts to Resolve Interference

Gray Graham, LKCM's Chief Engineer has contacted CCDVE's consulting engineer and alerted him to this interference problem. See attached "Statement Regarding Efforts to Inform and Resolve" in which Mr. Graham has also informed CCDVE that LKCM plans to file this pleading. As of this date, there has not been a response.

### U/D Data

Attached to the Engineering Statement is the undesired to desired signal strength indicating that the co-channel interference will exceed -20 dB at each of the listener's listening locations using the standard predicted contour methodology. See Table 1.


### Statement that Station KTFW-FM is operating with its license parameters

Accordingly, LKCM has demonstrated that pursuant to Section 74.1204(f), the pending application of Station K229DR to change channels to Ch. 221 should be dismissed.

This Engineering Statement has been prepared on behalf of LKCM Radio Licenses, L.P., licensee of FM broadcast station KTFW-FM, Ch. 22.1C1, Glen Rose, Texas (FCC Facility Id 65314). It is in support of an Informal Objection to the application FCC File Number 0000144788 and Facility Id 148350 for a co-channel FM translator which, if constructed, would cause objectionable interference to numerous KTFW-FM listeners in Midlothian, Texas and the surrounding area in violation of FCC Rule Section 74.1204(f).

**Compliance with Section 74.1204(f)**

As shown in the attached **Figure 1**, there is a significant area within the proposed translator's 60 dB $\mu$  F(50,50) contour that crosses into the 45 dB $\mu$  contour of KTFW-FM. The proposed translator's transmitter site is inside the KTFW-FM 45 dB $\mu$  contour. The predicted interference area, as indicated by the purple tinted area inside the KTFW-FM 45 dB $\mu$  includes most of Midlothian, Texas, which is an area that includes a significant number of KTFW-FM listeners. Additionally, one listener (4421 Jakes Way) is within 2 km of the transmitter, and is inside the 60 dB $\mu$  contour of the proposed translator facility. The area within the KTFW-FM 60 dB $\mu$  F(50,50) contour is home to some 340,274 residents. Per Table 1 to §74.1203(a)(3), KTFW-FM must provide a minimum of 8 listeners within the predicted interference area which listen to KTFW-FM at least twice a month.

Eleven KTFW-FM listeners have submitted declarations stating that they regularly listen to KTFW-FM and live, work, and/or commute in the area of the proposed translator's predicted interference area. All addresses were vetted and it was determined by geocoding that these addresses were within the proposed translator's interference area. Those 11 addresses are listed on the attached **Table I** and have been plotted on the map in **Figure 1**.

**Table I** also lists the predicted F(50,50) signal from KTFW-FM as well as the predicted F(50,10) interfering signal level of the proposed translator. In order for objectionable interference

to occur, the translator signal level must be 20 dB *below* that of the full service FM station. As shown on the table, all points plotted within the coverage map will be well above the level considered interference. In fact, the signals at these points range from 7.6 dB to 50.9 dB *above* the level at which interference is predicted to occur. Therefore, these 11 regular listeners would receive interference from the proposed co-channel translator as defined in Section 74.1204(f).

**Interference to Other Listeners**

The purple shaded area in **Figure 1** shows a portion of the area within the KTFW-FM 45 dB $\mu$  F(50,50) coverage contour that is predicted to receive interference from the proposed translator. All of addresses provided are located in this purple shaded area.

**Certification**

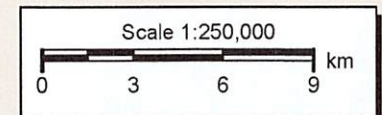




