Park Public Radio, Inc, ("PPR") through counsel, submits this Errata to correct 2 typographical errors in the Petition for Reconsideration ("Petition") filed in the above-referenced matter on Aug. 4, 2022.

In paragraph 7, second and third references in the Petition to a Commission Rule, 47 C.F.R. Sec. 1.934(f), did not include the dot between 1 and 9 – although it was initially cited correctly in footnote 3 to the Petition. To avoid confusion, the first two sentences of paragraph 7, should read as follows:
