**PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

TO THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS  
COMMISSION:

The undersigned, Omar Romero, Petitioner, respectfully urges the Commission to reconsider the grant of a license to cover to the licensee of K223DH. In support, Petitioner would respectfully show the following:

**1.** The licensee committed perjury in his application for license to cover. At the time submitted, licensee had not built out the station and did not have a lease for, or authorization from, the owner of the tower to broadcast from the licensed site. The undersigned has personal knowledge and can produce witnesses to verify that the licensee actually built out the station from another unauthorized site – e.g., a multistoried building located at 5847 San Felipe, Houston, TX 77057.

**2.** For the first time, on February 25, 2021, the licensee actually commenced broadcasting from the licensed site – e.g., a guyed-tower structure

located in Stafford, Texas. Noteworthy, is that licensee has no lease or authorization from American Tower to transmit any broadcasts from the site. Also noteworthy, although the license specifies directional operation with an SCA 2 SKEWED CL-CMS antenna pointed away from downtown Houston, the licensee is operating with an unauthorized Nicom BKG77 circular polarized omnidirectional 2-bay antenna, and is transmitting with power levels that exceed 1 kW. This signal is not only interfering with, but is totally obliterating the 30 watt signal of K223CW. See Attached Exhibits (11 pages).

**3.** Further, the undersigned verifies that the licensee of K223DH is not translating KBRZ-AM as shown in FCC records. Indeed, the licensee is not translating any station, but is instead originating programming in violation of FCC rules and regulations.

**4.** What is happening here is just another example of a continuing pattern of egregious and ongoing disrespect for the rules and regulatory authority of the FCC. The licensee also operates other overpowered translators in the Houston area – K202EP, K231CN, K258BZ, K258DA, K273AL -- most of which are also originating programming.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the undersigned respectfully requests the Commission conduct a full investigation and then reconsider the grant of license to cover to K223DH.
