Informal Objection

Good morning,

I am writing to file an informal objection to the renewal application of KPYM, Matagorda, TX, File No. 0000141602, Facility ID No. 198747, for having been silent for longer than the 12 month period permitted in 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

On September 2, 2020, Elohim Group Corporation requested Special Temporary Authority for KPYM to remain silent, stating that the station had been taken silent on August 10, 2020. It was further stated that a power outage in the area was the reason for the station going silent, and that “the station's silence also will be used to allow for the improvement and adjustment of certain aspects of the station”. Special Temporary Authority to remain silent was granted on October 27, 2020, and expired on April 25, 2021. The station's licensee confirmed KPYM's silent status was ongoing in an attachment to its renewal application filed March 29, 2021. It does not appear that any application to extend its STA was ever filed, and no notification of resumption of operations was filed. Its facility status remains “Licensed and Silent”. Therefore, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 312(g), KPYM's license automatically expired on August 11, 2021, and its license renewal application should be dismissed.
