STATEMENT FOR THE RECORD

Entravision Holdings, LLC (“Entravision”), the licensee of Station KDVA(FM), Buckeye, Arizona, and Prescott Valley Broadcasting Co. Inc. (“PVBC”), the licensee of Station KPPV(FM), Prescott Valley, Arizona, by their attorneys hereby submit this Statement for the Record in response to the Ordering Clauses of the Commission’s decision in *Entravision Holdings, LLC*, FCC 22-4, released January 25, 2022 (the “Decision”).

In the Decision, the parties to this channel change reimbursement dispute were given 30 days in which to undertake good faith negotiations in an effort to resolve their dispute as to the channel change and to establish the timing, manner, and extent of the reimbursement among themselves. Both Entravision and PVBC have communicated with each other, made offers, and exchanged comments and arguments as to the process and extent of permitted reimbursable expenses.


Despite the efforts of the parties, they were unable to bridge a substantial economic gap in the amounts they were either prepared to pay or accept, as the case may be, as the legitimate

and prudent expenses for the channel change to be undertaken by PVBC in order to comply with the terms of the outstanding construction permit for Station KDVA.

Consequently, Entravision and PVBC hereby report to the Commission that, despite their efforts, they are unable to reach a mutually agreeable understanding as to the legitimate and prudent expenses that Entravision must reimburse PVBC as a result of the channel change being implemented in connection with this proceeding.
