**INFORMAL OBJECTION**

South Bay Public Radio files this Informal Objection against Foundation For A Beautiful Life based on the following:

Foundation A Beautiful Life is the Applicant for Channel 225 Licensed to Cupertino, CA. South Bay Public Radio believes the 2<sup>nd</sup> Channel Waiver in regards to KRZZ on Channel 227B has a significant Population and Major Highways and 4 lane roads located in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Channel Overlap Zone and should be dismissed. The Proposed Transmitting site for Foundation For A Beautiful Life is located 56.2 KM from KRZZ and as demonstrated in our attached exhibit (Exhibit A) shows an Overlap Zone of 650 Meters. With a Proposed Radiation Above Ground Level of 60 Meters lowers the Overlap Zone to Approximately 590 Meters at Ground Level. Satellite imaging (Exhibit A) shows significant Population including Business, Homes, Highways and 4 lane roads inside this overlap zone. The applicant Foundation For A Beautiful Life fails to address this Overlap Issue or incorrectly states there is ZERO population inside this Overlap Zone.

South Bay Public Radio would also like to point out that South Bay Public Radio's Application (Facility ID 193000) Fully meets all spacing requirements on Co-Channel, First and Second Adjacent and is only MX to the Foundation For A Beautiful Life Application. South Bay Public Radio respectfully requests the FCC does it's own comprehensive check into the second channel overlap zone proposed by Foundation For A Beautiful Life and Dismiss the application due to the reasons stated above.
