I acknowledge that you have informed me about WVLT's complaint.

Since the translator is off the air, and you have complained about the pending modification application, I assume that you will make a 74.1204(f) showing. Without seeing that showing, so that I know where WVLT is claiming listeners, Broadcast Sciences is not in a position to propose a solution.

If you care to share with your showing before you file it with the FCC, Broadcast Sciences may be able to make a proposal. Otherwise, we will look at your filing when you submit it and will evaluate at that time whether there are any reasonable prospects for settlement.
