WITHDRAWAL OF INFORMAL OBJECTION OF LICENSE APPLICATION

By this letter, REC is withdrawing the *Informal Objection* on the above captioned license to cover application (License Application). Based on further investigation and interviews with parties to the application, REC has reached the conclusion that KCTC-LP is currently broadcasting and was broadcasting at the time when the Form 319 was filed. Therefore, we no longer hold an objection to the license grant.

Despite the withdrawal of the *Informal Objection* against the above captioned License Application, we are sustaining our *Informal Objection* to the transfer of control application, BTCL-20190523AAE (Transfer Application) for the reasons originally expressed in the *Informal Objection*.¹ In communications with the applicant, REC has suggested that they voluntarily dismiss the Transfer Application.²

² - In our further investigation on this matter, we also feel that there is no direct involvement of Counsel Dan Alpert in respect to the Transfer Application. The License Application and Transfer Application were independently filed and that Counsel had no role in effectuating the questionable transfer of control of an LPFM station that would have involved full-service familial attributable interests.
