OPPOSITION TO MOTION TO STRIKE

Northwest Rock ‘N’ Roll Preservation Society (NWR) herein opposes the Motion to Strike submitted by Bustos Media Holdings, L.L.C. Yes, we filed a Petition to Deny on behalf of our translator K281CI to protect the input channel 266, to which the above captioned translator proposal will cause unacceptable interference. We also filed informal objections to protect listeners of K266BM in and near the proposed 1mV/m contour of the proposed translator. We have eight declarations from regular listeners within that 1mV/m contour, which makes the above captioned application unacceptable for filing.

Section 73.3587 reads:

Before FCC action on any application for an instrument of authorization, any person may file informal objections to the grant. Such objections may be submitted in letter form (without extra copies) and shall be signed. The limitation on pleadings and time for filing pleadings provided for in Section 1.45 of the Rules shall not be applicable to any objections duly filed under this section.

The citations referenced by Mr. Kelly are for *licensed* facilities and those citations do not apply to informal objections. The informal objections to the above captioned application are valid. The Motion to Strike should be dismissed.
